3. **District and Sessions Judge Shahrukh Arjumand** will replace **Amjad Iqbal Ranjha** as special judge Central to hear new Toshakhana-II case against PTI founder Imran Khan and his spouse Bushra Bibi. He was nominated by Islamabad High Court after judge Amjad Iqbal Ranjha requested that he could not continue his services as special judge Central due to personal reasons and his services to be returned to Lahore High Court. 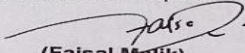

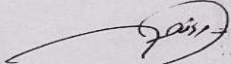

The Islamabad District Judiciary Service Tribunal, led by Justice Tariq Mehmood Jahangiri and comprising Justices Babar Sattar and Sardar Ejaz Ishaq Khan, issued the ruling on Friday while deciding an appeal by Senior Civil Judge Muhammad Shabbir. He had challenged the absorption of Shahrukh Arjumand as a Senior Civil Judge and his subsequent promotion to Additional District & Sessions Judge (AD&SJ).

The tribunal, in its short order, declared Arjumand's initial appointment "ultra vires" to the Islamabad High Court Act 2010 and the Islamabad Judicial Service Rules 2011. It cited a Supreme Court ruling (PLD 2016 SC 961) against the absorption of deputationists into permanent judicial positions and directed that he be de-notified and returned to his parent department, the Judicial Service of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Kabul's Test

The tribunal noted that after reserving its judgment on 13 March, it was informed by the Registrar that the Acting Chief Justice of the Islamabad High Court had verbally directed tribunal members not to issue ruling on pending appeals, as he had decided that the tribunal be dissolved.

In its ruling, the tribunal stated the Acting Chief Justice had "no

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issued a directive to reconstitute the tribunal. The tribunal later ruled that the order held no legal weight, as neither official had the unilateral power to dissolve or alter its structure.

The order further stated that the federal government and the President lacked jurisdiction to reconstitute the tribunal outside the established legal framework. It noted that the Acting Chief Justice's office had allegedly sought tribunal case files for placement before newly appointed members under the disputed notification.

Citing Supreme Court precedents, the tribunal reaffirmed that judicial independence must be maintained and that executive interference in tribunal composition was unlawful. It concluded that judges could not be removed through an illegal government directive.

The tribunal directed its Registrar to provide copies of the order to the Acting Chief Justice and the newly appointed judges. It reiterated that its original composition, established on 9 January 2024, remained intact and legally valid. The ruling firmly rejected the 18 March notification, warning that any attempt to alter the tribunal's structure outside the law was a violation of judicial independence.

In the 190 million Pound case, the hearing on Imran Khan and Bushra Bibi's appeals for suspension of their sentences was held on June 26, 2025. The NAB prosecutor had requested four weeks, but nine weeks have already passed, and they may get another week or two.

After June 26, the case was not scheduled again. In the second week of July, Imran Khan filed a petition requesting an early hearing, which was then fixed for hearing in the second week of September, almost two months later.

Now, the court only has to decide when to schedule the main case, i.e., the appeals for suspension of sentences, which will likely be listed for hearing in another week or two at the earliest.

In the petition seeking early scheduling of the appeals for suspension of sentences in the 190 million Pound case, the Islamabad High Court has directed, in accordance with court policy, that the case be scheduled soon for hearing.

At the start of the Toshakhana-II case trial, Imran Khan's acquittal petition was filed around January 15 of this year, and as of September 24, it remains at zero

progress no notices have even been issued yet. Justice Inaam Ameen Minhas is hearing the case.

Here's what happened: Initially, the case was placed before Justice Mian Gul Hassan Aurangzeb with objections. He instructed that the objections be removed. Then, on January 20, Justice Inaam Ameen Minhas was appointed as an Additional Judge. After the objections were removed, the case should have gone back to Justice Mian Gul, but the then Chief Justice Aamer Farooq instead listed the case before the newly appointed Additional Judge on January 23 even though high-profile cases are not usually assigned to Additional Judges.

Then, something happened that no one could have imagined. On January 23, another objection was raised that Justice Mian Gul Hassan Aurangzeb had already heard Imran Khan's bail case, so this case should also be sent to him. However, Justice Inaam Ameen Minhas dismissed the objection, saying, *"I will hear it myself."*

Later, on January 28, when the case was listed again, another objection was raised that Justice Inaam Ameen Minhas's brother was serving as a prosecutor against Imran Khan in the May 9 cases, so he should not hear this case. The court then ordered *further assistance* on the matter.

Since that day January 23 to September 24 the case hasn't moved forward even a single step. Two applications for early hearing were filed, and only after that was the case scheduled for October 7.

Meanwhile, the trial of the Toshakhana-II case itself is expected to be completed and decided within the next five to seven days, meaning that by then, the acquittal petition will automatically become ineffective.

7 October Toshakhana-II Proceedings

Imran Khan and Bushra Bibi's lawyer, Salman Safdar, requested the trial court to be restrained from delivering the final verdict in the Toshakhana-II case.

"I am issuing a notice," said Justice Inam Amin Minhas.

"If the trial court is not stopped from delivering the final verdict, then my arguments here are of no use," said Barrister Salman Safdar.

"We'll see," remarked Justice Raja Inam Amin Minhas — historic remarks — and the hearing was concluded with no next date given.

The unfortunate aspect is that no one knows what the Toshakhana-II case actually is what are the allegations, what evidence does the prosecution have, and what is the defense of Imran Khan and Bushra Bibi? None of this has ever been reported from Adiala Jail. If this trial had been held in any open court, the public would have known what the case was about.

6. **26th Constitutional Amendment (21 Oct 2024) Two Judges Amin Minhas & Muhammad Azam Khan were Appointed as Justice in IHC on 18 Jan 25.**

The 26th Constitutional Amendment in Pakistan (effective October 21, 2024) introduced a new process for appointing judges to the High Courts, including the Islamabad High Court (IHC), with a significant role now given to the Judicial Commission of Pakistan (JCP) and the Parliamentary Committee in the nomination and approval of candidates. Previously, the process involved recommendations and appointments with less direct parliamentary involvement. The amendment has been controversial, with concerns raised by groups like the International Commission of Jurists (ICJ) about its potential impact on judicial independence.

Details of the Appointment Process:

1. Judicial Commission of Pakistan (JCP):

The JCP is now responsible for nominating candidates for vacancies in the Supreme Court and High Courts.

2. Parliamentary Committee:

The Leader of the House and the Leader of the Opposition in the National Assembly will nominate members to a Parliamentary Committee.

3. Nomination to Committee:

The JCP, by a majority of its total membership, will nominate one person for each vacancy to the Parliamentary Committee.

4. Parliamentary Approval:

The Parliamentary Committee then formally approves the nominations to fill the vacancies.

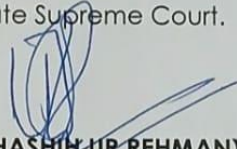

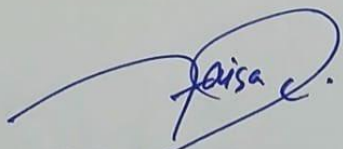

7. **31, January, 2025 (5 Judges Letter Regarding Transferred of Judges From from Punjab, Sindh and Balochistan**

Five judges of the Islamabad High Court (IHC) on Friday penned a letter to the chief justices (CJ) of the Supreme Court and high courts, urging them to take a stand against reports of a transferred judge being appointed to the IHC's top seat and to resist such a development.

Dawn reported last month that the judicial bureaucracy is reportedly planning to bring a judge from the Lahore High Court (LHC) to lead the IHC after the incumbent CJ's elevation. According to sources, a judge from the Sindh High Court (SHC) may also be transferred to the IHC.

Traditionally, the senior puisne judge of a high court is appointed as the chief justice, but the Judicial Commission of Pakistan (JCP) last year introduced new rules to bypass the seniority criterion in light of the 26th Amendment. The JCP proposed that the chief justice of a high court could be appointed from among the panel of five senior-most judges.

“In its judgement announced on June 19, the Supreme Court’s Constitutional Bench, had held by a majority of 3-2 that the transfer of three judges to IHC from Punjab, Sindh and Balochistan high courts was within the framework of the Constitution.”

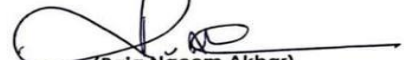

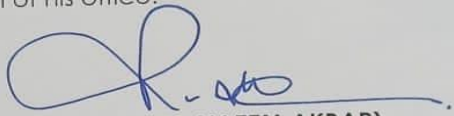

like-minded larger bench has been constituted in IHC

The division within the judiciary has become evident through the formation of the new bench: Is the Chief Justice the Master of the Roster or not?

In the Islamabad High Court, a *like-minded larger bench* has been constituted, comprising Justice Arbab Muhammad Tahir, Justice Khadim Hussain Soomro, Justice Azam Khan, and Justice Inaam Ameen.

This bench is being called “like-minded” because, in the full court meeting where the vote was split 6–5 in favor of the Chief Justice, four of those six judges who supported the Chief Justice are now part of this bench.

Moreover, Justice Inaam Ameen Minhas has previously ruled that the Chief Justice *is* the Master of the Roster, while Justice Sardar Ejaz Ishaq Khan has issued an order stating that the Chief Justice *is not* the Master of the Roster. Now, the situation is that Justice Inaam Ameen Minhas who supported the Chief Justice’s view has been included in the bench, whereas Justice Sardar Ejaz Ishaq Khan and the other judges who opposed the Chief Justice in the full court vote have not been included.
